Operation Hungry Picnic



The Picnic in the Park for the homeless and hungry will be held on Saturday, June 13th. Serving times are 10AM-2PM. As usual we will be providing individually wrapped desserts. Have desserts in the Fellowship Hall kitchen on Friday, June 12th. In addition to

the desserts we are asked to bring 2 tables (we will bring 3 or 4) and 10 chairs. Last year we had a downpour, so for those volunteering, keep a raincoat and/or an umbrella handy.

For those who do wish to volunteer, you can work as long as you want during the day. If you cannot be at Faith at 7:45AM on the 13th to load and head over to Pavilion #9 (new location), come when you can and leave when you must.

If you have any spare hats or sunglasses, we will be handing those out as well, but this is not something you need to go out and buy. We will also be making toiletry kits at the park, so if you have some sample sizes of toiletry items, please bring them. Also needed are a few ice chests if you can spare one for the day (with ice if possible).
