# 2020

1<sup>st</sup> Quarter:

Faith's LWW team members met at the Martin's home to begin charting the path to re-engage in this mission

March 8, 2020:

Faith's Session approves a motion, "to approve signing a covenant with Living Waters of the World to initiate the installation of a system in the Yucatan."

Late March 2020: World-wide pandemic causes shut down of church gatherings and functions, halts travel, LWW teams unable to leave/enter countries



# 2021

While the Covid-19 pandemic continues to wreak havoc with the best laid plans, vaccines become available and the world slowly begins to re-engage in travel. LWW teams are able to begin planning once again. Faith team sets its sights on the clean water needs of the Yucatan peninsula region of Mexico.




Summer:

Faith's LWW team is connected with experienced Houston (TX) area team that has been working in the Yucatan for many years. Discussions begin for partnership opportunities for Faith's team members to work alongside experienced Houston team members for its first installation.

October: Faith member Christi Robinson meets up with Houston team to assess two sites in the Tabasco region of Mexico. Covid-19 safety measures remain in place; negative test required to return home to the United States.

11-15-21: Faith's Session reaffirms the March 2020 commitment to proceed with a LWW Covenant to complete a project in Mexico, more specifically the Huimanguillo location in partnership with the Houston team.

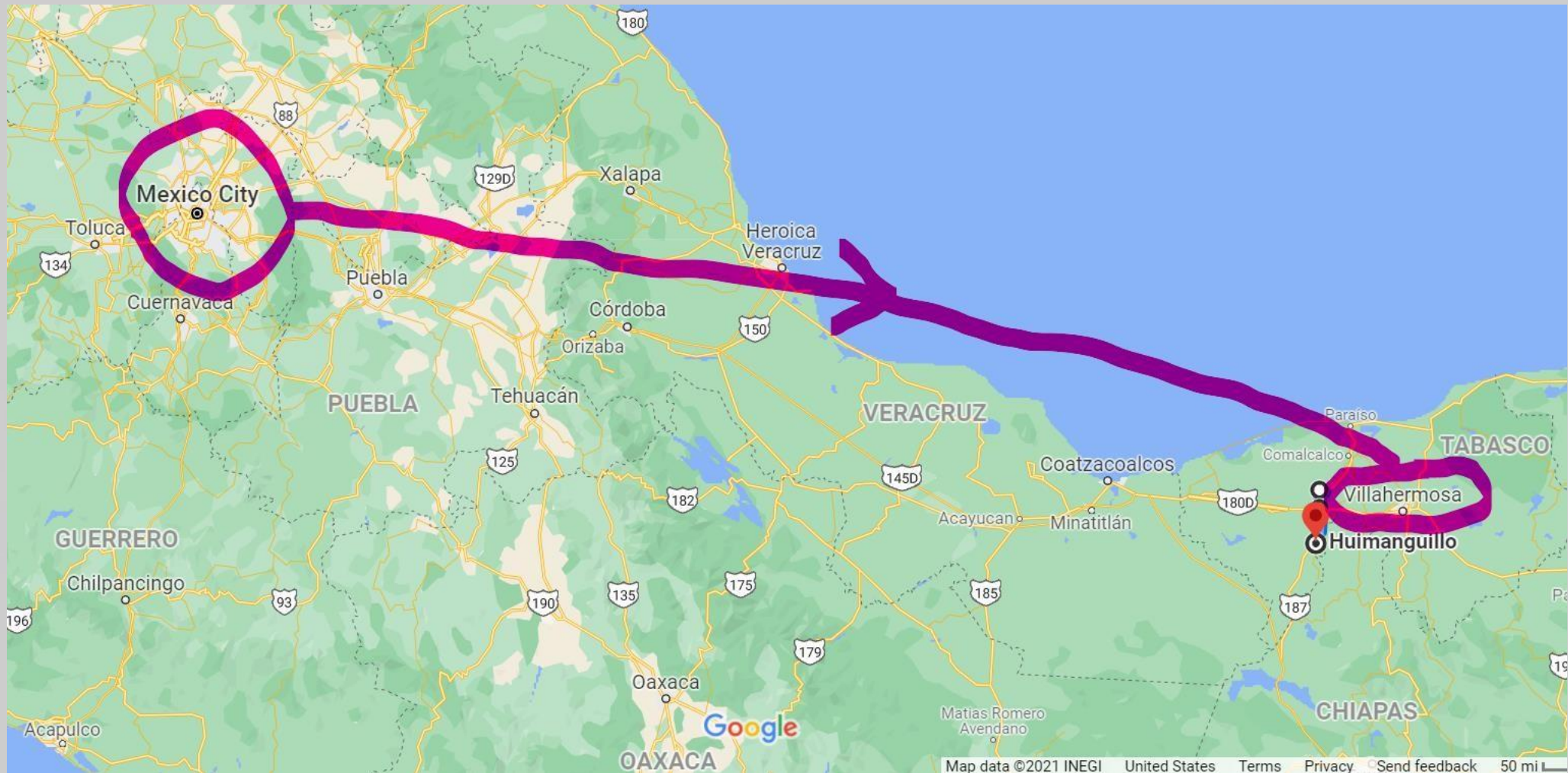




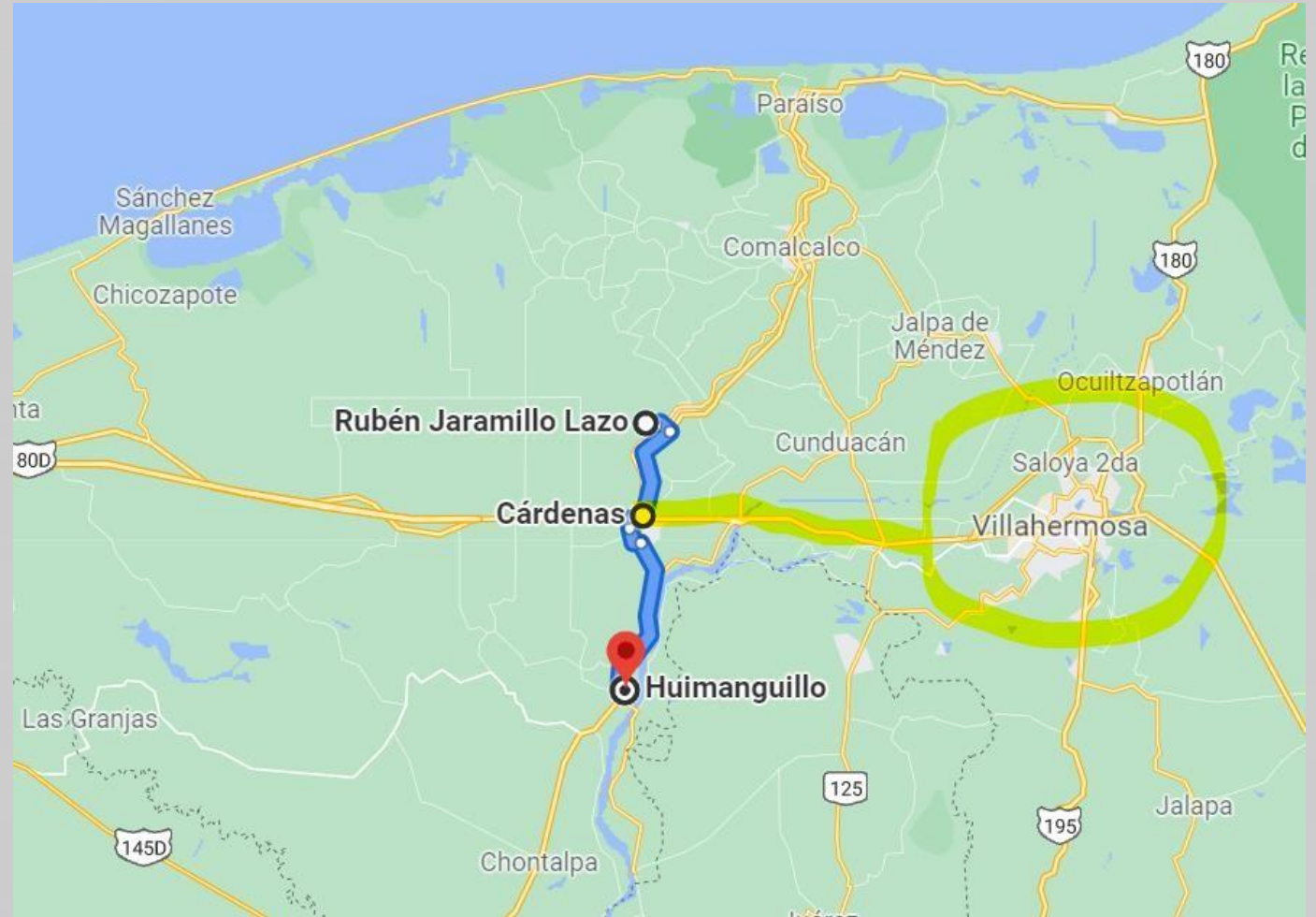
# Living Waters for the World – Huimanguillo Proposal

Faith Presbyterian Church (HSV, AL)  
November 4, 2021

Ends of trip bracketed by stay at Hyatt in Villahermosa (Pop. 914,000). No direct international flights there from US so fly into Mexico City, go through customs & immigration there then board domestic flight from Mexico City to Villahermosa. Can complete and print color immigration form ahead of time (must print as double sided document), also download App required for Mexico health check

## CURRENT SYSTEM

No current treatment

Existing 15m deep well

## LOCAL WANTS/NEEDS

New building for treatment plant area is proposed

New, deeper 30m well proposed

Desire to serve local rural population as outreach mission of church

Church elders appear to have skilled labor and financial resources to construct the building needed. They have approx. 7.5 acres of land at camp.

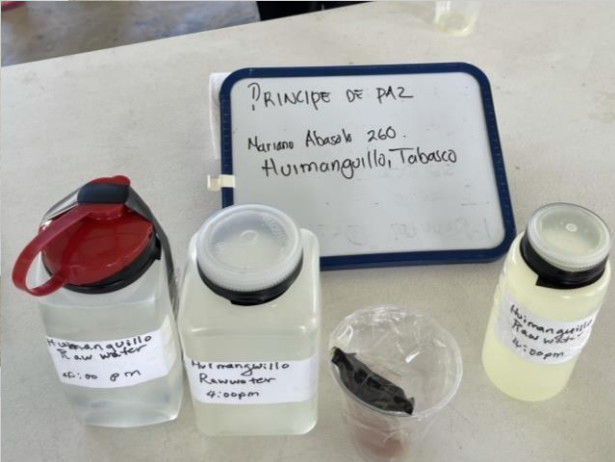
## TREATMENT NOTES

Septic (?) system for camp restrooms reported to exist, exact location to be determined

Source water samples taken from current well, but may not be in same lens as proposed well

YROS is assumed to be required based on local experience
