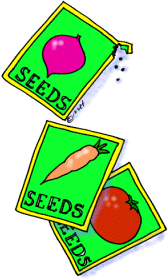

**Crop Drop News:** The Mission Committee is disappointed to say we will not have a crop drop this year. The Society of St. Andrew organizes crop drops, to put to good use for hungry people, farmers' gleanings or unmarketable produce which would otherwise be discarded or destroyed. Once the volunteers for a crop drop have bagged all of the produce, the bags are distributed to local feeding agencies. Many churches and organizations are clamoring to take part in this encouraging and compassionate activity. SoSA wants to give other organizations a chance to "spread the produce and love," so they have asked us to defer the opportunity this year. Since SoSA wants to encourage us to continue our efforts for our hungry neighbors, they are working on a possible substitute volunteer project for us this year: a seed-packing event. We might be the first group to carry out this kind of project and SoSA is still working on the details. When the Mission Committee members know more about details of the event, we will certainly publicize them, and we hope for lots of participants from Faith.
