### **Seed packing event Saturday, October 26**

Join us in the Fellowship Hall at 9:00 am for a new project for the Society of St. Andrew (SoSA), the group that sponsors crop drops. We are not eligible to have a Crop Drop this year, so we will be doing a new project for SoSA. We will put cucumber and beet seeds from larger into smaller packages which SoSA will distribute to feeding agencies including Enable, thus building caring communities by offering nourishment to hungry neighbors. We expect to finish no later than noon.

This is the first time for a seed packing event, and we do not know all the details of how it will work. Everything we need will be provided. Having worked with SoSA many times, we know this project will help address hunger issues.
